To (PCR checked and approved by the SVR) prepare the life cycle assessment [LCA], specific data were collected from the Chemofast Anchoring GmbH manufacturing facility in Willich. The assessment is based on data from 2020 which correspond to the yearly Issue date average. The procedure by which the data are allocated to the declared unit is described in the "Allocation" section. Product

Product description/Product definition

The declared product PASF is a two-component reaction resin mortar based on polyester resin that is delivered in a two-component plastic cartridge or foil tube cartridge. The PASF product is applied through a static mixer using a manual, battery-operated or pneumatic gun. It was developed as a cost-effective alternative for securing threaded rods and internally threaded sleeves in approved applications. It can also be used safely and easily in perforated brick by using a perforated sleeve. PASF offers a good range of applications at environmental temperatures of up to 80 °C.

Marketing of the product in the EU/EFTA (except for Switzerland) is governed by Regulation (EU) No. 305/2011 (CPR). The product requires a Declaration of Performance subject to ETA-11/0285 and ETA-12/0341 and the CE-marking, European Technical Assessment Chemofast PASF.

Application

The declared product PASF is used to reliably secure threaded rods and internally threaded sleeves. Use in cracked concrete and solid and perforated brick is possible with industry standard anchor rods.

Suitable for securing façades, canopies, wooden structures, metal structures, metal profiles, panels, railings, gratings, plumbing fixtures, pipes, cable trays etc.

Base materials/Ancillary materials

The declared product PASF is delivered as a two-component plastic cartridge and consists of a resin component and a curing agent component in a 10:1 volume ratio. The mixing ratio between the resin component and the curing agent component is set automatically as the product is pushed out of the cartridge. Curing begins immediately after the components are mixed.

Reference service life

The declared product PASF may be exposed to a wide range of environmental conditions during the use phase. Its expected reference service life depends on the specific installation



situation and on the product's resulting exposure. The main factors influencing service life are weather conditions and mechanical and chemical stresses.

Declared Unit

The product declared is a two-component reaction resin mortar manufactured by Chemofast Anchoring GmbH with the product name PASF. The declared unit is based on 1 kg reaction resin product in the ratio at which the two components must be mixed before use.

The mixing ratio between the resin component and the curing agent component is 9:1 [m/m] (volume ratio 10:1). The packaging is also included in the calculation at 0.3013 kg per 1 kg of reaction resin product. The declared unit data are presented in the table below.

The precursor products are sourced from Germany, Belgium, Italy and France. Transport is mainly done by truck. The following process diagrams illustrate the underlying production process.




Figure 1 Information modules A1 to A3 of the product




Figure 2 Information modules A1 to A3 of the packaging

At the waste treatment facility, the construction waste is shredded and then

disposed in a landfill.
